Papers presented during the conference will be included in the conference volume, published by "Alexandru Ioan Cuza" University Press of Iasi. Upon selection, the best articles can be published in a special issue of the journal *Transformations in Business & Economics* (indexed in Clarivate Analytics Web of Science Core Collection – Social Sciences Citation Index, http://www.transformations.knf.vu.lt/), at the author's publication expenses. Alternatively, selected papers can be published (free of charge) in *Scientific Annals of Economics and Business* (indexed in Clarivate Analytics Web of Science Core Collection – Emerging Sources Citation Index, http://saeb.feaa.uaic.ro/index.php/saeb) and *Review of Economic and Business Studies* (indexed in various international data bases, http://rebs.feaa.uaic.ro/).

## **Conference fee (per participant):**

- 150 lei for PhD students
- 300 lei for teaching staff and researchers.

A maximum of 2 papers per author is recommended.
